### Demand Side Management

#### Allan Crandlemire, CEO, Efficiency Nova Scotia Corporation

Efficiency Nova Scotia Corporation (ENSC) is an independent corporation created to help Nova Scotians use energy better through electricity and non-electricity programs, solutions and incentives for homes and business. Allan Crandlemire, CEO of ENSC, will explain how energy efficiency or Demand Side Management (DSM) will not only help businesses improve their bottom lines, but will drive a new sector within the energy industry - a new sector that already employs hundreds of Nova Scotians and generates more than \$30 million in business for contractors, retailers and suppliers. In the process, Nova Scotia is reducing its environmental footprint and becoming a leader in the efficient use of energy.

### The Centre for Sustainability in Energy & the Environment

#### Donald J. McIsaac, Director of Facilities Management, Cape Breton University

The Centre for Sustainability in Energy and the Environment (CSEE) at Cape Breton University was designed as a compact and efficient building form, incorporating a range of energy and environmental enhancements that will deliver a high performance building. Donald McIsaac will discuss some of the 'green' features of this current project, including geothermal heating and cooling, solar thermal heating, wind generation, displacement ventilation and use of green materials and methodologies.

### BOMA BEST Presentation

**BOMA BEST (Building Environmental Standards)** is a national program launched in 2005 by BOMA Canada to address an industry need for realistic standards for energy and environmental performance of existing buildings based on accurate, independently verified information.

Today, BOMA BEST has evolved from simply identifying key best practices to providing common standards; an array of educational and on-line assessment tools; independent data audits; and a four-level performance certification program. The certification is available for office buildings, shopping centres, open air retail and light industrial properties.

A short introduction will be given on the main aspects of BOMA BEST following a presentation to the most recently certified buildings.
